

23 BLG lawyers recognized in Lexpert Special Edition: Health Sciences 2026

Canada (July 8, 2026) - BLG's health sciences practice has earned 23 recognitions in the 2026 edition of [Lexpert Special Edition: Health Sciences](#), spanning health law, medical negligence, life sciences, corporate health transactions and intellectual property.

Published annually, *Lexpert Special Edition: Health* identifies leading Canadian lawyers across the full spectrum of health law practice. BLG's 23 recognized lawyers reflect the firm's depth across the health sector – from complex hospital infrastructure and governance to landmark health policy challenges, class action defence and medical education law.

Recent mandates handled by BLG's recognized lawyers include:

Hospital Infrastructure

BLG served as lead counsel on Canada's largest hospital project: the C\$13.9 billion public-private partnership for Trillium Health Partners' Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital and Shah Family Hospital for Women and Children.

Hospital Governance

BLG served as counsel to the government-appointed supervisors in two of the three Ontario hospitals placed under provincial supervision in 2024, reflecting the firm's depth of health sector governance expertise.

Hospital Investigation

BLG served as lead counsel on the internal investigation at London Health Sciences Centre that uncovered an alleged fraud scheme spanning more than a decade. BLG subsequently launched a C\$50 million civil action and secured certificates of pending litigation over 43 properties owned by the defendants.

Hospital Merger

BLG served as lead multi-disciplinary counsel on the merger of Grand River Hospital and St. Mary's General Hospital to form Waterloo Regional Health Network, a combined system with an annual operating budget of approximately C\$1 billion.

Medical Education

BLG structured the legal and governance framework for Toronto Metropolitan University's new medical school and Integrated Health Centre, supporting nearly C\$180 million in provincial investment and C\$25 million in federal funding. The school opened in Sept. 2025 with 94 inaugural students.

Class Action Defence

BLG defeated certification in a proposed class action involving more than 15,000 individuals against The Hospital for Sick Children relating to the Motherisk Drug Testing Laboratory, with leave to appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada subsequently denied.

Health Policy

BLG represented the Black Physicians of Canada in a successful challenge to an Ontario residency policy restricting internationally trained medical graduates. Ontario announced it would rescind the policy on March 24, 2026.
